



Notes on 360⁰ leti

When to go:

1st October - 31st May

October - March offers the best views of the Himalaya. The wild cherry trees come into blossom in Oct/Nov and then Dec/Jan can become cold at night, however, a time when the mountain views can be at their best. March – end May is when the rhododendrons come into bloom which is a wonderful sight, although the mountain views can be a little hazy. From mid April through to end of May it becomes warm during the day.

Accommodation:

4 cottages – all en-suite and with private sit outs and glorious views. The bathrooms have overhead showers, hot and cold water, stunning brass basins and teak floors. Aesthetically designed to absorb the surroundings. For the winter months, the rooms are heated.

Communal living/dining area with glass walls, enabling maximum enjoyment of the views around.

Electricity:

Solar powered electricity for guests to charge laptops/cameras/ipods. No internet access. Mobiles will not work, although Shakti staff have mobiles that work (local networks) in case of emergencies.

Cuisine:

A variety of cuisine, including Indian, Tibetan, Continental and Asian. Guests are welcome to attend demonstrations by our chef. Fine wines and spirits.

Activities:

Accompanied by a private guide and a picnic breakfast/lunch, walk to a local Hindu temple or a village, or perhaps to the adjacent hill for an even greater mountain view. Yoga and meditation sessions can be organised on request at time of booking.
